By the mid-1970s the discipline of pediatric hematology-oncology nationally was defined The American Board of Pediatrics established a sub-board, and a process for formal assessment of fellowship training programs was initiated a few years later Late 1970s Dr George Buchanan joined Drs Cornet and Sartain on the faculty in 1977
